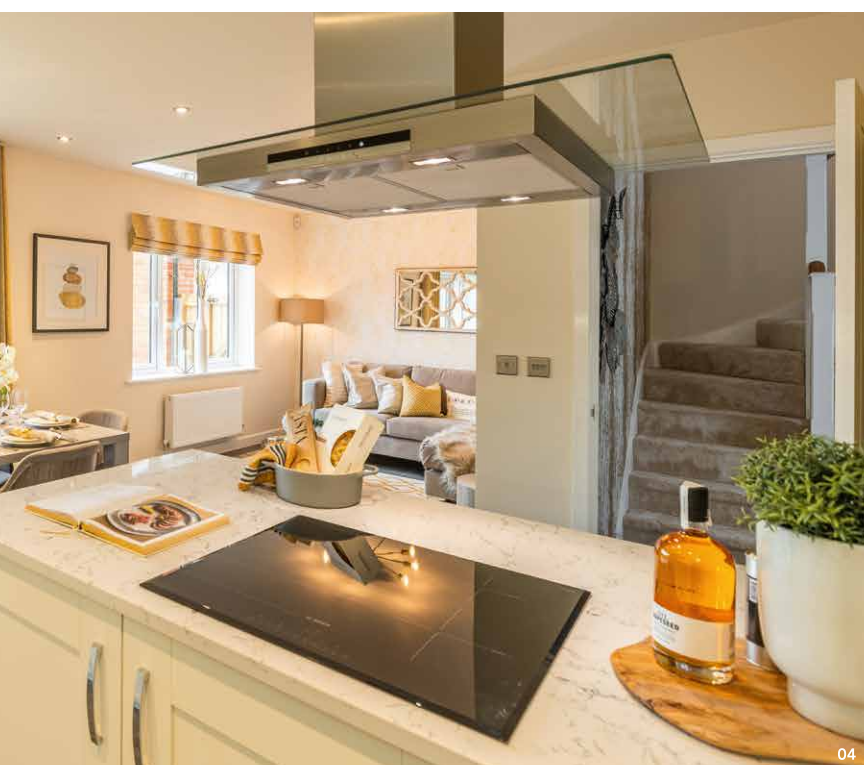

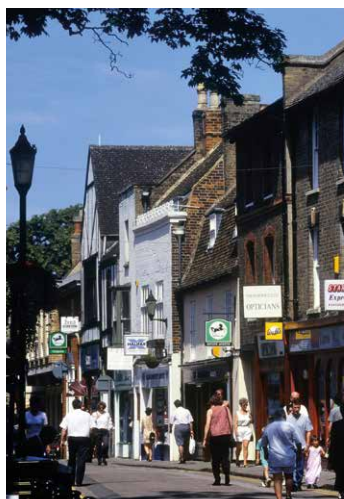

Buckden benefits from a historic high street with wonderful restaurants and shops. The George Hotel is a beautiful 18th century coaching inn and provides a welcome place to eat and sleep.

Whether you are looking for a quiet drink with friends or a Sunday lunch with the family, The Lion Hotel is one of the oldest coaching inns in England. Dating back to 1492, it continues to retain much charm, character and atmosphere.
