
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Exchequer Court Buildings are located in the hamlet of Thruxton on the edge of the Whitfield Estate close to the village of Kingstone. The area is surrounded by beautiful rolling countryside. Kingstone is located in the upper Wye Valley, southwest of Hereford, close to the Golden Valley. The village includes a public house; The Bull Ring Inn, post office, Doctors surgery, village hall and village church. The village also benefits from childcare facilities plus its own primary and high school, both rated 'Good' from Ofsted. The property is within easy striking distance of the Cathedral City of Hereford and the market towns of Ross-on-Wye and Abergavenny, just seven, fourteen and nineteen miles respectively, all providing local amenities including independent shops, pubs, cafés, churches, cricket and golf clubs. There is a wide range of state and public schools in the catchment area and National Hunt racing at Hereford. Travel links within the area are good with the A465 linking to Hereford. From Hereford to Ross-on-Wye, the A49 links to the M50 which joins to the M5. Hereford is on the main Manchester to Cardiff railway line with rail-links to Birmingham New Street and London Paddington. International airports are located at Cardiff, Bristol and Birmingham.

Exchequer Court Buildings enjoys an attractive rural setting surrounded by beautiful rolling countryside. A unique opportunity to purchase four building plots with far-reaching views of the Herefordshire countryside. The project benefits from Full Listed Building Consent for four high quality spacious country properties comprising of a three bedroom detached unit, a pair of two/three bedroom semi-detached units and a four bedroom unit. The development has commenced as demolition has taken place.



Directions

From Hereford take the A465 towards Abergavenny. At Locks Garage turn right onto the B4348 towards Peterchurch, Kingstone and Thruxton. Continue for approximately 1 mile and then turn left onto the lane signed Abbeydore and Cockyard. After approximately 0.2 miles turn left opposite the lane for St Bartholomew's Church. Take the first entrance next to the first property on the left.
