
DESCRIPTION

The Church of St Michael Paternoster Royal was founded and built by Sir Richard Whittington, Mayor in 1397. It was destroyed in the Great Fire of London and re-built by Sir Christopher Wren. It was damaged during the Second World War and restored with the addition of office accommodation in 1968. It is Grade 1 listed.


The property is no longer used for worship and can be used for a variety of business uses under Class E of the Town & Country Planning Act, subject to consent from the Diocese of London and the Church Commissioners.

LOCATION

The property is located on College Hill at the junction with College Street. Cannon Street station is located within easy walking distance and offers both underground and mainline services. Mansion House, St Paul's and Monument underground stations are also close by.







ACCOMMODATION


The property is self-contained, available in its entirety and comprises the following approximate floor areas, located over basement, ground and three upper floors.








Stained glass windows

The grant of a lease will then be conditional on the outcome of the publication of a draft Pastoral (Church Buildings Disposal) Scheme under the provisions of the Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011, including a statutory period of public consultation, agreement of the Church Commissioners' covenants and the prospective tenant being granted planning and listed building consent (if required) for its proposals.
