THE SITE – EX22 6AU

This desirable development opportunity, extending to c. 0.14 acres, comprises a site located close to the town centre and benefitting from outline planning approval for the construction of two new dwellings. Although all matters are reserved for future approval in terms of layout, scale, access and design, indicative plans submitted with the outline application show the construction of two new detached dwellings (a 3 and a 4 bedroom townhouse), each with detached garage and off road parking. Interested parties may also wish to consider the development of a single, substantial dwelling on the site (subject to all requisite consents).

HOLSWORTHY

Holsworthy has a weekly Pannier Market, good range of national and local shops together with a Waitrose supermarket, BP filling station, Marks & Spencer's Simply Food and Wild Bean café. There are a whole range of amenities within the town including a heated swimming pool, sports hall, bowling green, cricket club, 18 hole golf course etc. Close by is the Ruby Oak Park with its swimming pool ideal for children and Bude on the Cornish coast some 15 miles to the north.

PLANNING

Outline planning approval ref. 1/1040/2022/OUT was granted by Torridge District Council on 24th February 2023 for the erection of two new dwellings with all matters reserved. Copies of the planning approval notice, proposed plans and associated documents are available from the Agents upon request.

UTILITIES

The Agents are advised that a foul drainage connection exists on site and a surface water drainage statement and soakaway report has been carried out in October 2022 demonstrating that a geo-cellular soakaway structure could accommodate all surface water arising from the site to account for 1 in 100yr storm event plus 40% allowance for climate change. A plan showing proposed soakaway locations has been provided as part of the outline application. Interested parties are advised to make all necessary enquiries with relevant utility companies as to the availability and capacity of services prior to making any offer.

Land off Chapel St, Holsworthy



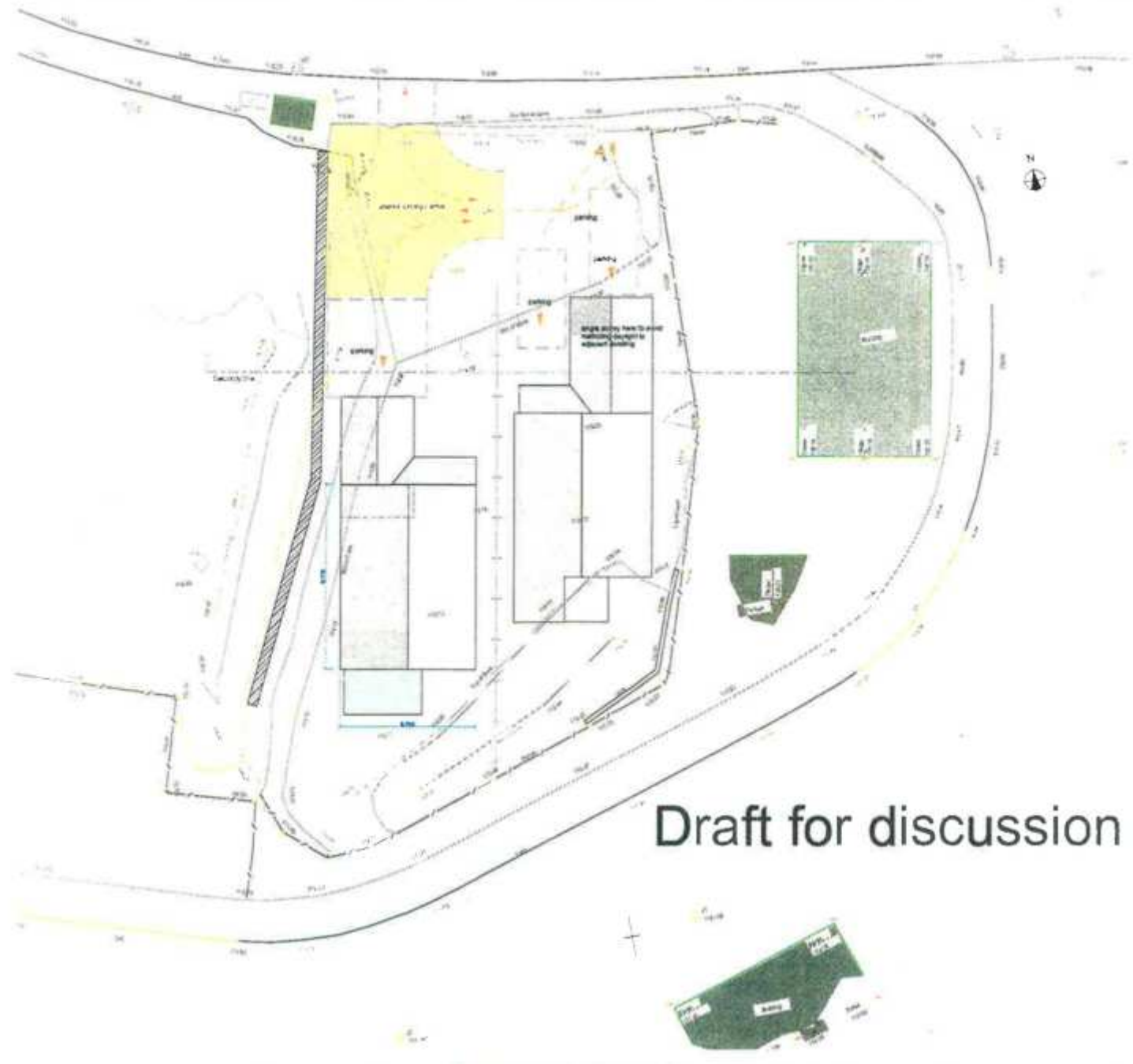


KEY
